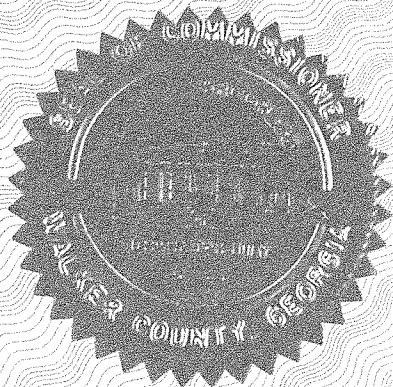
Senior Citizen's Day Proclamation
