**A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET TO SUPPLEMENT THE
GENERAL SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS GENERAL FUND OF THE WALKER COUNTY
ANIMAL SHELTER AND ADOPTION CENTER AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 4-11-9.3 provides that it shall be the duty of any person impounding an animal under code sections of Georgia law to make reasonable and proper arrangements to provide the impounded animal with humane care and adequate and necessary veterinary services, including, but not limited to, providing shelter and care for the animal at any state, federal, county, municipal, or governmental facility or shelter

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 36-81-3 (d) requires any increase in appropriation at the legal level of control of a local government, whether accomplished through a change in expected revenues in any fund or through a transfer of appropriations among departments, shall require the approval of the governing authority by ordinance or resolution; and

WHEREAS, The Walker County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center is a legally constituted department of Walker County Government, tasked with the responsibilities of providing humane care and adequate and necessary veterinary services to impounded animals; and

WHEREAS, The Walker County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center is in need of funding to carry out and accomplish its responsibilities, including spaying and neutering impounded dogs and cats; and

WHEREAS, The Walker County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center receives donations for the purposes of helping to defray the costs of operations and to carry out and accomplish its responsibilities, including spaying and neutering impounded dogs and cats; and


WHEREAS, The Walker County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center has received a donation in the amount of \$10,000 for said operations;

THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED,


1. That the Walker County governing authority appropriates \$10,000 to the General Supplies and Materials General Fund of the Walker County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center.
