

RESOLUTION R-014-18

A RESOLUTION AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2018 BUDGET TO REALLOCATE \$5,000 FROM GENERAL LEDGER ACCOUNT NUMBER 100.1545.531200.30 TO CAPITAL FUNDS FOR THE TAX COMMISSIONER

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 36-81-3 provides for a County to adopt a “summary line item” legal level of budgetary control whereby the governing authority controls county spending; and

WHEREAS, Resolution R-019-17 established the legal level of budgetary control for Walker County at the summarized object classification level (e.g. Personnel Expenses, Operating Expenses, Capital Outlay); and

WHEREAS, the Tax Commissioner has requested a budget change from operating expenses to capital outlay in an amount that would allow compliance with a state-mandated unfunded transition from the current operating software used by the Tax Commissioner’s Office to the Driver Record and Integrated Vehicle Enterprise System (DRIVES) software system; and


WHEREAS, an available amount to be moved from operating expenses without interfering with operations is \$5,000 from an energy line item; and

WHEREAS, the Tax Commissioner and her staff have been working very hard to prepare for full implementation of the DRIVES system on May 27, 2019;


THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED,

1. That the Walker County governing authority hereby amends the FY 2017-2018 budget to reallocate \$5,000 from general ledger account number 100.1545.531200.30 to the Tax Commissioner’s capital outlay budget.
