

RESOLUTION R-036-18

A RESOLUTION OF THE SOLE COMMISSIONER OF WALKER COUNTY SETTING THE COUNTY SUPPLEMENT TO COMPENSATION FOR THE WALKER COUNTY STATE COURT SOLICITOR

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 15-18-67 (b) provides that the county governing authority is authorized to supplement the minimum compensation to be paid to the solicitor-general of the state court of the county; and

WHEREAS, upon the retirement of the current state court solicitor and the uncontested election of a state court solicitor in November, there will be a new state court solicitor of Walker County; and

WHEREAS, the minimum amount of compensation to be paid to the solicitor under local law is less than \$84,000 per year; and


WHEREAS, the governing authority believes that \$84,000 per year is an amount comparable to state court solicitors in other counties in the region and in counties of similar size to Walker County;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sole Commissioner of Walker County, Georgia that the county supplement to the minimum compensation to be paid to the solicitor assuming office in January 2019, shall be an amount which shall make the total compensation of the state court solicitor \$84,000 per year.


