Minutes of the Regular Scheduled Meeting

June 25, 2020

I. Call to order

Commissioner Whitfield called to order the Regular Scheduled Commissioner's Meeting held at Annex III, 201 S. Main Street, Lafayette, Georgia at 6:00 PM on June 25, 2020.

II. Attendees:

The following persons were present: Commissioner Shannon Whitfield, Planning and Zoning Director David Brown, Public Relations Director Joe Legge, County Clerk Rebecca Wooden. Other guests signed in at the meeting as well, please see the attached sign in sheet.

VI. Commissioner Whitfield approved and signed the minutes from the two Public Hearings and the Regular Scheduled Meeting on January 23, 2020

VII. New Business

- I. Commissioner Whitfield reviewed Purchase Order 2020-00001248, 2020-00001249 and 2020-00001298 from Walker county Sheriff's Department requesting purchase of 8 new vehicles from Prater Ford. Captain Chris Anderson was present and discussed how the Sheriff's Department puts approximately 100,000 miles on vehicles per year and how it has been challenging to find vehicles but were able to find these from Prater Ford and Opelika Ford, Chrysler, Dodge, Jeep.

Commissioner Whitfield commented that these were all included in the budget and Walker County doesn't have to finance for these vehicles, they will be paid for when purchased. These vehicles will be used for court services and mostly road patrol.

- II. Commissioner Whitfield read and approved Resolution R-011-20 Awarding of Demolition and Removal Contract for Project DRBS-2020-01. He explained this is for the blighted structures and upon opening the sealed bids in a public meeting the lowest bid was \$16,030.00 from North Georgia Groundworks, LLC. The bids range from \$16,030.00 to \$71,762.00 and several bids in between. Those are all available online for review if anyone has any questions regarding these bids.
- III. Commissioner Whitfield read Resolution R-012-20 Re-Appointing of Marie Thomas to the Chickamauga Public Library Board. He stated that a Thank you letter would be sent to Ms. Thomas and a letter would be sent to Ms. Lecia Eubanks, Director of the Cherokee Regional Library showing of the appointment.
- IV. Commissioner Whitfield read and approved Resolution R-013-20 Appointing John Howard to the Walker County Board of Tax Assessors. He stated Mr. Howard was previously on the Board of Tax Assessors and has had the required training and is willing to serve the citizens of Walker County. This board is governed by the department of revenue at the state, and there is a certain amount of training and tests they have to pass before they can even vote on anything. They can go to meetings and participate, but until they've obtained their training certifications they cannot even vote on any action items. Since this is a midterm, we've got someone that had been on the board and served in the past and has this training. He can step back onto this board very quickly and keep things running as smooth as possible. Commissioner Whitfield stated that he appreciated Mr. Howard and his service and a thank you letter would be mailed to him as well.
- V. Commissioner Whitfield stated that Resolution R-014-20 was on our Agenda but was accidentally left out of the packet. He stated it is the governing authority's responsibility to appoint members to the local county Department of Family and Children Services board made from specific categories from within the community. At this time he is re-appointing Charles Helton to serve as a member of the DFCS Local County Advisory Board.
- VI. Commissioner Whitfield reviewed Purchase Order 2020-00001044 to Bellamy Strickland Commercial Truck Sales on the purchase of a vehicle for Grounds Maintenance.
- VII. Commissioner Whitfield discussed the proposal from Chase Reline, Inc. on slip line and installation. This was during Covid-19 and needed for the repairs to be done and we had to have this to complete the repair

work. Commissioner explained the tornadoes that come through on Easter, we had a culvert that was, I think, about eight foot diameter. And I forget what the length was on it, but it went under the road and an old railroad bed. I think it was over a hundred feet long. The culvert failed and washed out part of the road. And it was going to be a major, major expense. It was 120 feet long, 84 inches in diameter and it was going to cost us over \$100,000.00 and the estimate was to dig it up and replace it, and probably about two weeks worth of work. So we were referred to Chase Reline, Inc. and happened to be located in Chattanooga. We had a company in Atlanta; tell us about a company in Chattanooga. And so we reached out to them and they actually come out and re slip line this culvert top for \$53,950, which was almost half of what it was going to cost to replace it. Plus there are some residents that live on Shinbone Road that was probably going to have to be walking to their house or driving through the woods to get to their homes. We've been very happy with this, being an emergency repair, this work has been completed, but again, since it was a capital improvement of over \$15,000, we wanted to bring this forward to let people know and have a copy of this and be aware of how we've invested \$53,950 of your tax dollars to put a road back in service. Commissioner signed and approved this proposal.

- VIII.** Commissioner Whitfield accepted the recommendations from the Planning Commission and approved the application from Pruetts Supply Inc. request for a conditional use variance for property located at 2081 S. Hwy 27 LaFayette, GA. 30728. Tax map & parcel number 0-490-1-005.
- IX.** Commissioner Whitfield accepted the recommendations from the Planning Commission and approved the application from DFP LLC request for a conditional use variance for property located at 0 Glentana Street Rossville, GA. 30741. Tax map & parcel number 0-133-088A.
- X.** Commissioner Whitfield accepted the recommendations from the Planning Commission and approved with conditions the application from Douglas Daugherty request for a rezone from A-1 to R-1 for property located at 312 Allgood Road Flintstone, GA. 30725. Tax map & parcel number 0-049-065. The conditions are with the understanding of a new drive to be put in to accommodate the house behind them.
- XI.** Commissioner Whitfield accepted the recommendations from the Planning Commission and approved the application from Grenda Jo Thompson requests a rezone from A-1 to RA for property located at 1452 Veeler Road LaFayette, GA. 30728. Tax map & parcel number 0-339-056.
- XII.** Commissioner Whitfield accepted the recommendations from the Planning Commission and approved the application from Roy Dewayne Tankersley request for a rezone from C-1 to R-2 for property located at 1901 McFarland Ave. Rossville, GA. 30741 Tax map & parcel number 0-156-094A.

The Agreement (“Agreement”) dated January 24, 2017, between Walker County Commission (“Landlord”) and State Properties Commission (“Tenant”) for 5,852 rentable square feet of Office space located at 1212 North Main Street, LaFayette, GA 30728-2135, will expire on June 30, 2020.

The Agreement referenced above granted to Tenant the option to extend the Term for additional periods of one (1) year each. The notice period for exercising the option is the later of 45 days or five days following the signing of the next fiscal year budget by the Governor, which typically is by May 15. Due to the Governor’s declaration of a public health emergency, the fiscal 2021 budget is not likely to be signed until the second half of June this year.

The State Properties Commission (“SPC”) cannot legally exercise the renewal option until the Governor signs the budget. Therefore, if the renewal notice is not received by the usual date, this does not mean that the Tenant will not exercise the option to renew. SPC will send authorized renewal notices as soon as practicable after the budget is signed, and this may be shortly before the end of the current lease term.

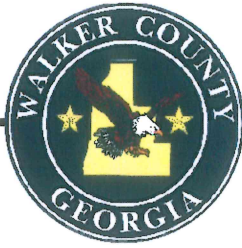

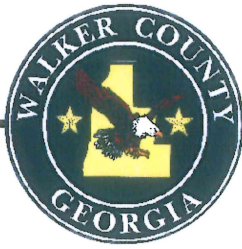
