A RESOLUTION OF THE SOLE COMMISSIONER OF WALKER COUNTY TO ACCEPT A PROPOSAL FOR 911 EMERGENCY AND NON-EMERGENCY AMBULANCE SERVICE – PROJECT 2020-EMS1

WHEREAS, Walker County, Georgia ("County") is licensed by the state of Georgia to provide 911 emergency and non-emergency ambulance services within the entire geographical limits of the County; and

WHEREAS, the County issued RFP #2020-EMS1 ("RFP") requesting proposals from vendors to contract said 911 emergency and non-emergency ambulance services; and

WHEREAS, the County has reviewed all of the proposals submitted by the vendors; and

WHEREAS, the County has made its decision that the most responsible, responsive and reliable vendor that satisfies all of the requirements set forth in the RFP is CHI Memorial Hospital-Georgia (Inc.) d/b/a CHI Memorial Hospital EMS ("CHI Memorial Hospital EMS");

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Sole Commissioner of Walker County, Georgia that RFP #2020-EMS1 is accepted from CHI Memorial Hospital EMS, contingent upon the County and CHI Memorial Hospital EMS executing a contract pursuant to the provisions of the RFP. The County is authorized to take all necessary action to prepare and execute the contract. This resolution shall also serve as the Notice of Intent of Award referenced in the RFP.
