A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WALKER COUNTY TO DECLARE PROPERTY FROM THE DISTRICT ATTORNEY'S OFFICE AS UNSERVICEABLE SURPLUS AND REMOVED FROM THE COUNTY INVENTORY

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 36-9-2 provides that the county governing authority shall have the control of all property belonging to the county and may, by order entered on its minutes, direct the disposal of any real property which may lawfully be disposed of and make and execute good and sufficient title thereof on behalf of the county; and

WHEREAS, the District Attorney for the Lookout Mountain Judicial Circuit has requested the property listed on Exhibit A be deemed unserviceable surplus and further requests that the property be removed from the County inventory;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia that the property listed in **Exhibit A** attached hereto, and made a part hereof, be hereby declared unserviceable surplus and removed from the County inventory.
