



RESOLUTION R-050-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE WALKER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO INCREASE THE SUPPLEMENT TO COMPENSATION FOR THE WALKER COUNTY STATE COURT JUDGE

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 15-7-22 provides that judges of the state courts shall be compensated from county funds as provided by local law; and

WHEREAS, O.C.G.A. § 15-7-22 further states the county governing authority is authorized to supplement the compensation thus fixed to be paid to the judges of the state court of that county; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Walker County is the governing authority of Walker County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the State of Georgia approved a \$5,000 cost of living adjustment (COLA) in its Fiscal 2023 budget for many state employees and elected officials; and

WHEREAS, the Walker County State Court Judge did not receive this COLA; and

WHEREAS, the County has budgeted for this COLA;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia that the annual county supplement to compensation paid to the State Court Judge shall be increased \$5,000, effective January 1, 2023.
