



RESOLUTION R-042-22

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WALKER COUNTY TO FURTHER DEFINE THE BOARD CLERK AS A DEPUTY CLERK OF THE GOVERNING AUTHORITY OF WALKER COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (“Board”) is the governing authority of Walker County; and

WHEREAS, Section 14 of the enabling legislation creating the Board provides that the Board is authorized to appoint a clerk to keep a proper and accurate book of minutes; and

WHEREAS, the Board exercised that power on March 11, 2021 appointing a part-time Board of Commissioners Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the Clerk of the Governing Authority, also known as County Clerk, is officially responsible for the County seal and the retention and preservation of official records, including meeting agendas, minutes, resolutions, ordinances, and appointments to boards, committees and commissions, as well as preparing official correspondence and reports, among other functions; and

WHEREAS, it would be a benefit to the citizens of Walker County to have a Deputy County Clerk, who could act in the absence of the County Clerk assuming responsibilities required to continue the operations of the office;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia that the position of Board Clerk shall also serve as a Deputy County Clerk.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that despite this designation, the Board Clerk shall continue to serve at the will of the Board of Commissioners.
