



RESOLUTION R-006-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE WALKER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO ESTABLISH CERTAIN TRAINING CRITERIA FOR CONTINUED SERVICE ON THE WALKER COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Walker County is the governing authority of Walker County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, the Board supports the desire of members of the Walker County Planning Commission to serve our community; and

WHEREAS, one tool available to the Board to assist Planning Commission members is to provide for training on the fundamental concepts of land use issues, so members can make effective and informed recommendations; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia that all existing members of the Walker County Planning Commission must complete six-hours of training in zoning procedures and/or comprehensive planning conducted and/or sponsored by ACCG, GMA or the University of Georgia's Carl Vinson Institute of Government.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED the County will provide each member with a supplement to offset the expense of this required training.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that failure to receive six-hours of training by July 31, 2023 will be grounds for removal from office by the Board of Commissioners.
