

RESOLUTION R-043-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WALKER COUNTY
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE
ACCEPTANCE AND ISSUANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR NEW LICENSES FOR
RETAIL PACKAGE SALES OF DISTILLED SPIRITS**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners (“Board”) passed Resolution R-029-24 on August 22, 2024 enacting a temporary emergency moratorium on the acceptance of applications for new licenses for retail package sales of distilled spirits; and

WHEREAS, the Board needed time to review and prepare appropriate amendment(s) to the County Alcohol Ordinance, to hold public hearings required by law, and to adopt such amendment(s) and other ordinances; and

WHEREAS, with the adoption of Ordinance O-02-24, the need for a temporary emergency moratorium on the acceptance of applications for new licenses for retail package sales of distilled spirit no longer exists;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia does hereby repeal Resolution R-029-24.
