

**RESOLUTION R-043-24**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WALKER COUNTY  
FOR THE PURPOSE OF REPEALING A TEMPORARY MORATORIUM ON THE  
ACCEPTANCE AND ISSUANCE OF APPLICATIONS FOR NEW LICENSES FOR  
RETAIL PACKAGE SALES OF DISTILLED SPIRITS**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Commissioners ("Board") passed Resolution R-029-24 on August 22, 2024 enacting a temporary emergency moratorium on the acceptance of applications for new licenses for retail package sales of distilled spirits; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board needed time to review and prepare appropriate amendment(s) to the County Alcohol Ordinance, to hold public hearings required by law, and to adopt such amendment(s) and other ordinances; and


**WHEREAS**, with the adoption of Ordinance O-02-24, the need for a temporary emergency moratorium on the acceptance of applications for new licenses for retail package sales of distilled spirit no longer exists;


**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Commissioners of Walker County, Georgia does hereby repeal Resolution R-029-24.
