



RESOLUTION R-014-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF WALKER COUNTY TO APPOINT MEMBERS TO THE LIMESTONE VALLEY RESOURCE CONSERVATION & DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Walker County (“Board”) is the governing authority of Walker County, Georgia; and

WHEREAS, one of the duties delegated to the Chairwoman of the Board is to appoint members to all committees of the Board with the approval of the Board; and

WHEREAS, the Limestone Valley Resource Conservation and Development Council requires member counties to appoint an official representative and a citizens’ representative at the beginning of an odd numbered year; and

WHEREAS, Commissioner Brian Hart and David Matteson are qualified and willing to continue to serve on the board of the Limestone Valley Resource Conservation and Development Council; and

WHEREAS, Chairwoman Teems submits the following appointments to serve as a representative of Walker County on the board of the Limestone Valley Resource Conservation and Development Council for terms that began January 1, 2025 and will end on December 31, 2026:

Commissioner Brian Hart to serve as Walker County’s official representative
David Matteson to serve as the citizens’ representative from Walker County

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board that the appointments of Commissioner Brian Hart and David Matteson to the Limestone Valley Resource Conservation and Development Council are approved.
